MISSION STATEMENT:

“ Angels for Animals believes that animals, as living creatures, have value beyond economic measure. Our mission is to educate the people of our community about pet over population and regular veterinary care for pets: cultivate an awareness and responsibility toward the needs of companion animals; provide for the well being of our community’s animals that are abandoned or otherwise in need; and instill respect for and the appreciation for all living things.”

NOTE: Volunteers must be at least 12 years of age. Teens from 12-16 years must have a parent or legal guardian volunteering with them at all times. Any volunteer under 18 years needs their parent/legal guardian’s signature on the volunteer application.

Kennel Work

We have two cleaning shifts scheduled twice a day at the shelter, and at two area PetSmarts. Volunteers are needed to clean, feed and care for the animals. This would involve working directly with the animals.

Adopters

Special volunteers are trained to adopt animals to the public. This requires knowing the personality of each of the animals in order to place them in the proper homes. It also requires an understanding of adoption and fostering policies and procedures. Volunteers are trained in basic care of the animals such as general grooming.

PetSmart® (Boardman and Niles)

Volunteers are needed at these locations where we have cats available for adoption. Duties include cleaning cages, interacting with the cats and taking adoption applications.

Front Office Work

Volunteers are needed to answer the phone and greet the public during the hours of shelter operation and to be able to give out basic information and answer general questions. We also need front office support during non-public hours to answer the phone and assist with basic office functions.

Medical

Volunteers are needed to clean and disinfect the surgical area, serve as a receptionist for the medical area and care for the animals in the recovery area.

Special Events & Fundraisers

We have many fundraising events throughout the year. Volunteers are needed to work and organize the individual events. Help is required to plan, set up, work the event, and clean up.

General Maintenance

We are always looking for help with general building and equipment maintenance to include helping with basic electrical and plumbing tasks.
