Angels has a vision to help animals and our community like never before. We want to build a new wing that will be a model for animal welfare and will start a legacy of caring that will last beyond our generation. The new Angel Wing will be a place for all animals – and for the people who love them. It will be an emergency clinic that won't charge sky-high prices, located right here, instead of an hour away. It will be regular vet care that is convenient and affordable. And it will be a shelter for lost and displaced animals.

What's more, Angel Wing will be a holding place for sick animals that need to recover before entering the shelter with the other animals. It will be a place that can bring spaying and neutering to area animal agencies that currently don't offer the service, helping our community control animal overpopulation.

It will be a place of hope and healing. Compassion and companionship. Faith and trust. Angel Wing will be a place to go, and a place to heal, 24/7 and 365 days a year. It builds upon Angels for Animals mission: to nurture humane life, humane death and to transform the future of animal care.

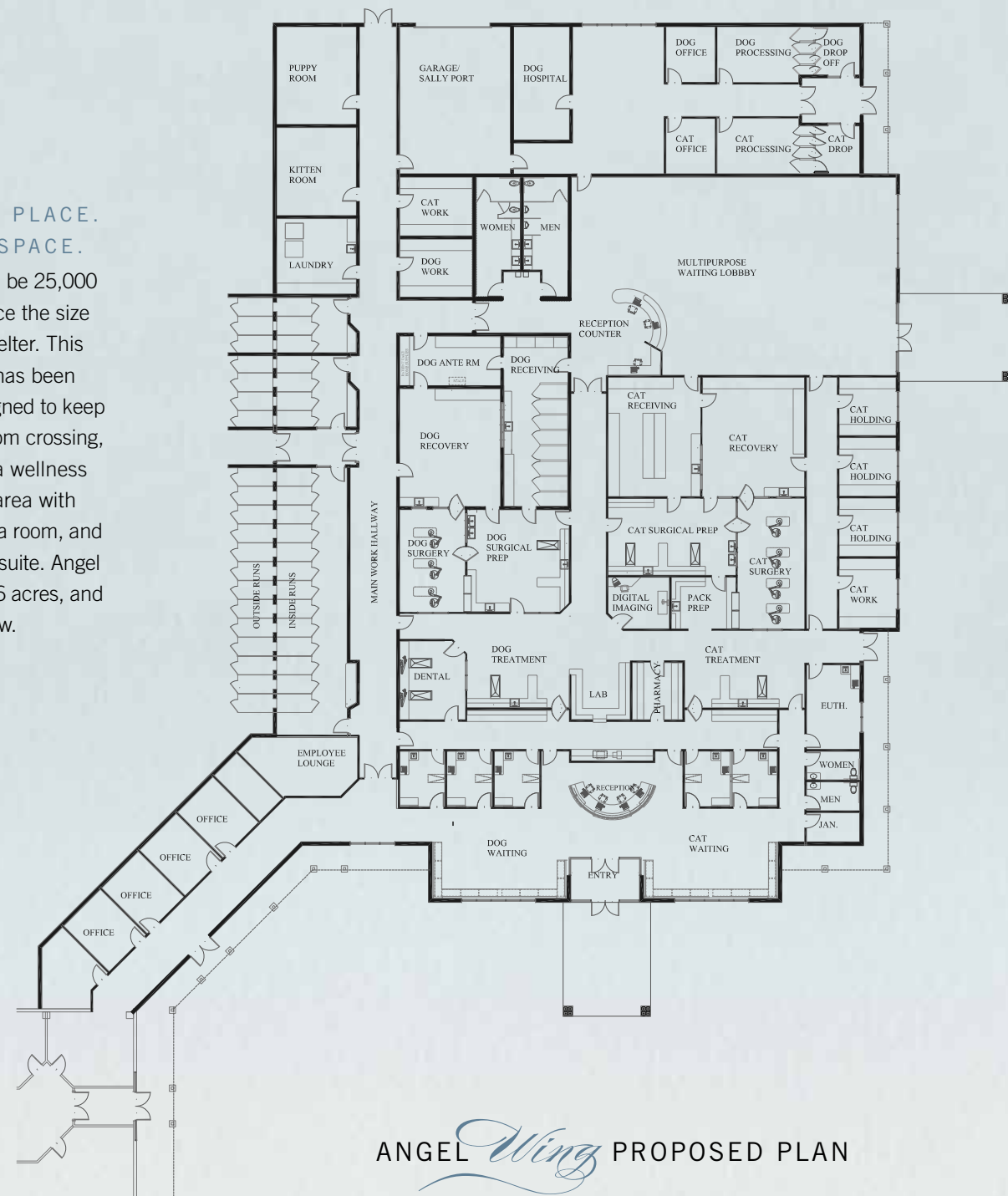
WHERE THE NEED IS GREAT, THE SOLUTION MUST BE EVEN GREATER.

The need to care for our region's most vulnerable animals is not only immense, it's a matter of life and death. Currently, our county's Humane Society has just two humane officers, which makes it impossible for them to get to every site of reported abuse or neglect. State highway patrols encounter countless animals along the highways and interstates. And when police go on a domestic disturbance call, they often find pet abuse. What happens to all these vulnerable, unwanted animals?

The new Angel Wing will fill this care gap, and give these animals the aid they deserve. It will be a place that will welcome animals any time of the day and night and provide shelter and medical care around the clock. Since 1990, Angels for Animals has worked to deal with many of the animal issues in our community. We have a legacy of serving every animal that makes it to our door. And we want that legacy to continue.

**A HEAVENLY PLACE.
A HEALING SPACE.**

Our new wing will be 25,000 square feet – twice the size of our current shelter. This veterinary clinic has been thoughtfully designed to keep animals’ paths from crossing, and will feature a wellness area, treatment area with private euthanasia room, and separate surgery suite. Angel Wing will sit on 36 acres, and have room to grow.

A LOOK AT THE FUTURE SPACE.

The Angel Wing will compliment the Lariccia Animal Center. The Center will continue to house our adoptable pets and retail center. The basement’s crowded surgery area will move to the Wing, allowing the building’s lower entrance to become a receiving area for the shelter. Our popular Wellness Clinics will also move to the Wing, freeing up our private dog visiting rooms for prospective adopters.

A HEALTHY SEPARATION. The main advantage of the Wing is that any animal with a medical condition will go to the new facility where our medical team is located. This will keep unwanted viruses out the adoption kennels and separate “finished” animals that are adoption-ready from animals that are “unknown” and unevaluated.

A WARM WELCOME. The Wing’s front entrance will have a reception area for public vet appointments, along with restrooms.

DOGS THIS WAY. CATS THAT WAY. Upon entry, cat patients will go to the right and dog patients to the left. Individual exam rooms will be equipped with lights, exam tables and sinks.

VETS AND ASSISTANTS THIS WAY. Medical personnel will enter from the back of the individual rooms from a well-equipped treatment area.

LEADING-EDGE TREATMENT AREA. Rooms for dentals, X-rays and ultrasounds. Pharmacy and doctor/RTV offices.

ON THE EAST SIDE. An outside entrance will lead to Exam Room 6 to accommodate euthanasia and very sick or injured animals. This gives grieving pet parents desired privacy. An additional public entrance will be used to drop off abandoned animals.

WAY TO LOBBY. During surgery intake times, the inner lobby doors will open to the large waiting area to accommodate spay/neuter patients. Our comfortable, large lobby with restrooms will also serve as “flex” area for lectures and dog training.

VISIBLE RECOVERY. Separate dog and cat recovery rooms will be visible through glass walls to the vets doing surgery.

EAST SIDE CATS. WEST SIDE DOGS. Cats will live on the East Side, dogs on the West Side.

SECOND FLOOR LIVING. Dorm-style housing will enable college students and interns to live on site as the Wing strives to be full service and 24/7.
