MISSION STATEMENT:

“Angels for Animals believes that animals, as living creatures, have value beyond economic measure. Our mission is to educate the people of our community about pet overpopulation and regular veterinary care for pets; cultivate an awareness and responsibility toward the needs of companion animals; provide for the well-being of our community’s animals that are abandoned or otherwise in need; and instill respect for and appreciation of all living things.”

NOTE: Volunteers must be at least 12 years of age. Teens from 12-16 years must have a parent or legal guardian volunteering with them at all times. Any volunteer under 18 years needs their parent/legal guardian’s signature on the volunteer application.

Adopters: (MUST BE AT LEAST 18 TO FINISH ADOPTIONS, ALTHOUGH YOUNGER AGES CAN ASSIST)

Special volunteers are trained to adopt animals to the public. This requires knowing the personality of the animals in order to place them in the proper homes. It also requires an understanding of our adoption and fostering policies and procedures.

General Maintenance:

We always need help with general building and equipment maintenance.

Kennel Work: (MUST BE AT LEAST 16 TO WORK WITH THE DOGS)

We have two cleaning shifts scheduled every day at the shelter, to clean, feed and care for the animals.

Medical: (MUST BE AT LEAST 18 TO WORK IN MEDICAL AREAS)

Volunteers are needed to clean and disinfect the surgical area, cat and dog holding areas.

Office Work:

Volunteers are needed to answer the phone and greet the public during the hours of shelter operation. These volunteers must be able to give out basic information and answer general questions.

Special Events & Fundraisers:

We have many fundraising events throughout the year. Volunteers are needed to work the events, which includes set-up and clean-up.
